Job Description

Under the supervision of a Project Manager, this person will fabricate and assemble plastic tanks, parts, prototypes, and other products using a CNC router, welder, various saws, and other shop tools. This person may also contribute to the design, development, and optimization of proprietary products.

Essential Functions/Job

- 1) Fabricate and assemble plastic products, applying knowledge of working characteristics of plastics and bonding techniques, using precision instruments, hand tools, power tools, machines, and equipment
- 2) Read and interpret written and verbal instructions to execute work orders
- 3) Cut material to size, using shears, knives, cutters, scissors, router, or saws
- 4) Weld plastics together to plan specification, using a plastic welder
- 5) Trim, drill, grind, and finish parts to specifications, using templates, hand tools, and power tools
- 6) Perform typical machine shop operations to support the production and fabrication of plastic parts
- 7) Maintain the work area and equipment in a clean orderly condition and follow prescribed safety regulations to ensure a healthy, safe, and tidy workplace
